### 8. Objective

The bridge in Palmera Street , Sitio Baliksaka, Bgy Pinugay was totally damaged by typhoon Tonyo and Ulysses which affect mainly the irrigation system and the transporting public .Hence the economy and livelihood of the constituents are the major concern of the damaged. This damaged was duly reported by the Municipal Risk Reduction Officer to National and Provincial Government.

From the Assistance program of the Local Government Support Fund- Disaster Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Assistance Program (LGSF- DRRAP) Baras is one of the beneficiaries to rehabilitate the damaged caused by typhoon Tonyo and Ulysses. Total fund of Php 4,041,055 was downloaded to support the damage. Portion of the fund from Php 4,041,055.00, Php 3,541,055.00 was allotted for the rehabilitation of the bridge in Baliksaka to reconstruct the damaged bridge.

### 9. Description

The Project Rehabilitation of Bridge in Palmera Street ,Sitio Baliksaka , Barangay Pinugay , Baras Rizal was composed of 40 pcs reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) with a diameter of 1.370 meters , Slope protection on each side of the Road and a concrete pavement of 61 meters long, 6.0 meters wide and thickness of 200mm.

### 10. Changes in Project Scope and design

There is no Changes in project design. The project is completed according to plans , specifications and detailed engineering design.

### 11. Causes of project Implementation.

Inspite of the situation, the Covid-19 pandemic, there is no delay in the implementation of the project. Health protocols were observed and implemented during the implementation of the project.

### 12. Project Cost Convergence.

Alloted budget for the project was Php 3,541,055.00. The difference between the approved budget cost and the contract amount will be reverted to the National Treasury.

### 13. Recommendation

Riprapping or slope protection along the riverbank is recommended to protect the bank of the river from erosion and the river from siltation. Siltation may cause the reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) to be clogged in the future and will affect the flow of water from upsteam to downstream.



#### 8. Objective

The KANGKONG LIVELIHOOD PROJECT FOR FISHERFOLKS located in Bgy Santiago was totally damaged by typhoon Tonyo and Ulysses which affect the livelihood of the fisherfolks/kangkong growers from BGy Santiago and Bgy Evangelista .Hence the economy and livelihood of the said fisherfolks/ kangkong growers are the major concern of the damaged. The objective of the Project is to provide them with the needed supplies to rehabilitate the Kangkong cages . This will help the beneficiaries to recover from the damaged caused by the typhoon. This damaged was duly reported by the Municipal Risk Reduction Officer to National and Provincial Government.

From the Assistance Program of the Local Government Support Fund- Disaster Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Assistance Program (LGSF-DRRAP), Baras is one of the beneficiaries to rehabilitate the damaged caused by typhoon Tonyo and Ulysses. Total fund of Php 4,041,055 was downloaded to support the damage. Portion of the fund from Php 4,041,055.00, Php 500,000 was allotted for the rehabilitation of the kangkong livelihood project.

### 9. Description

The Project :KANGKONG LIVELIHOOD PROJECT FOR FISHERFOLKS LOCATED IN BGY SANTIAGO has total area of 13.16 hectares in Bgy Santiago and 8.9 hectares in Bgy Evangelista .Twenty two (22) fisherfolks/Kangkong growers owned 0.56 hectares each and 35 fisherfolks/ kangkong growers owned 0.26 hectares each. Total area of the 56 fisherfolks/ kangkong growers was damaged by typhoon Tonyo and Ulysses.

### 10. Changes in project Scope

Conduct of Quarterly meeting for the organized group (kangkong growers) should be regularly conducted and regular monitoring of the area to avoid expansion of the cages without the permit from the municipality. The group should be organized and should established Bagsakan Center operated by the municipality to help the group to market their product with high market value.
